Classes G – N Wheeled entries may be included but cars and vans (with or without music) WILL NOT BE JUDGED. There must be at least one adult with each entry in class L, M and N

NB. Individual and groups of children 16yrs and under will be judged in the Children's Fancy Dress competition on Wednesday 19th at 2pm on the Lawn. They may filter into the procession at John Nash Drive on Thursday provided an adult accompanies them.

CUPS

- The Davey Cup and £15 will be presented to the best overall entry in classes B – F. 1st prize winners must remain on their floats to ensure you are ready for judging. Do not move from your original position
- The Doble Cup and £15 will be presented to the best overall entry in classes G – N. 1st prize winners please move to the front of your section to ensure you are ready for judging.
- The Spears Cup and £15 will be presented to the best local float.

All winners will receive their cups and Prize money at the time of judging.

IT IS IMPORTANT THAT THE RECEIPTS FOR THE CUPS ARE SIGNED AND RETURNED TO THE JUDGES IMMEDIATELY

JUDGING

Judging will start promptly at 5.45pm. Entrants must ensure they are in their correct class ready for judging by 5.30pm.

On arrival please report to the committee table (pre 5.30pm) or judging marshal (5.30pm to 6pm) displaying your class letter and check that you are entered in the correct judges list. If you wish to enter on the night and would like to be judged please arrive by 5.30pm and inform the judge of your class that you wish to be entered on their list. You will be given a "You have been judged card" when judging of your entry is complete.

FACILITIES

Toilet facilities and refreshments will be available near the committee table marked on the map. Collecting buckets and tins can also be collected at this table.

COLLECTIONS

Please note that all monies collected in tins and buckets, or on the floats, belong to Dawlish Carnival Committee. Only officially labelled buckets or tins should be used. There will be large identifiable containers on most Royalty floats so that heavy collecting buckets can be emptied into them en route. All monies should be handed to the event marshals at the collecting point outside the Shaftesbury Theatre at the end of the procession route.

| CLASSES A – F | Please assemble in John Nash Drive. When you receive your class card it will have a number as well as your class letter. Please look for your class area and park in that space moving as far forward as possible to the front of the class (leave at least 5 metres between you and the entry in front) |
| CLASS G – M | Please assemble in the Oaklands School Field accessible near the committee table |
| CLASS N | Please assemble in the Ratcliffe School Driveway leading uphill from the committee table |
| MAJORETTES & BANDS | Please assemble on Richards Close/Linden Estate opposite Class A |

PROCESSION SAFETY GUIDELINES

The Carnival Committee does not accept responsibility for accidents or injuries to participants in the procession.

If any entrants are found to be drinking alcohol (particularly any drivers) any monies or cups won will be confiscated and the float pulled out of the procession. Any person found throwing liquids or missiles will also be removed from the procession. We have a number of points where floats can be pulled out mid procession if needs be.

Towing vehicles need only be fully insured and both the towing vehicle and float should comply with all traffic regulations for road worthiness.

All floats using generators should have them suitably ventilated and would be advised to carry a small 3kg powder fire extinguisher stored in an easily accessible position away from the generator. Where choice permits please use fire retardant materials to dress your float.

In classes A – F all individual entrants on floats should have handholds and children must wear restraining straps when the float is moving whether they are in a sitting or standing position.

Each float should have a float supervisor walking beside the float appointed to be in liaison with the driver. This person should wear a reflective jacket to stand out from the public. This person will be the first point of contact for marshals.

Drivers should endeavour to keep at least 5 metres from the entrant in front whether walkers or another vehicle, both on the move and when the procession is static. This is necessary in the event of there being any emergency en route.

Therefore please do not close up completely if the procession stops and wait to be informed of procedure by one of the event marshals.

Inform one of the marshals immediately if you encounter any problems with your entry on route

Be aware that spot checks may be carried out at any time.
